This Indenture made and entered into this the 18th day of October, 1860, between one thousand eight hundred and sixty, between Sally Bailey of the first part and Georgianna Bailey of the other part, both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Witnesseth, that the said Sally Bailey of the first part in consideration of love and affection which she hath and beareth for her daughter the said Georgianna Bailey and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by the said Georgianna Bailey, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth sell, grant and convey unto the said Georgianna Bailey her heirs and her heirs forever, that tract or parcel of land in which she now resides it being the same which the said Sally Bailey purchased of Milton G. Brown, and wife by deed bearing date the 16th day of January 1841, and of record in the Clerk's office of the County of Southampton, and for boundaries of said land see said deed, the said Sally Bailey party of the first part, however reserves to herself the sole use and occupation of said land during the term of her natural life free from all rents and charges whatsoever.
