In trust to secure the following securities, and debts owing, to secure and save from all loss Richard L. Bryant as security for the said Rochelle in the debts which the said Rochelle owes to Robert S. Barnes, guardian of C. Caswell C. Ferguson, James J. Darden, Executor of H. B. Britt, George L. Pope, and in all cases in which he may be security as aforesaid amounting to about one thousand dollars; also to save from all loss as security Samuel A. Darden, Sixth St. Bishop, and Charles S. Hill in all instances in which they may be bound for the said Rochelle to Robert S. Barnes, Sarah Ford, James J. Hill, and in all other cases. Also to secure to Richard Lewis Bryant the payment of a debt due by bond executed by me to him this day for a debt assumed by him this day for one hundred and twenty five dollars. The foregoing liabilities to be discharged in the first place and before all others.

And to secure in the second place the following debts due by the said Rochelle - One bond to Samuel Kells for about one hundred and fifty dollars. One bond to Lucy W. Kindred for about three hundred and fifty dollars - one bond to Benjamin R. Kindred for about thirty dollars and account to Margaret J. Banister for about two hundred dollars - account to Beale of Abbeville, for about fifty dollars. Account to James M. Cobbett & Co. for about fifty dollars, account to Williams for about forty dollars, account to Darden for about twenty dollars. account to Joseph Marshall for about fifty dollars, account to King & Tay for about fifty dollars account to R. J. Sinclair for about seventy five dollars - account to H. V. Niemeyer for about fifty dollars - account to Pebbles Taylor for about twenty five dollars - account to Richard S. Darden for about twenty dollars (or more) - account to Richard S. Peltz for about twenty dollars - account to Wm. W. Briggs for about thirty dollars. But it is expressly agreed and stipulated that the said Rochelle shall retain undisturbed possession and use of the tract or parcel of land upon which he now resides for the period of five years from this date, and it is further understood that the said Rochelle makes this Deed and further that those persons herein mentioned who are unwilling to abide by said provision shall have no benefit from this Deed.

And in the event of a sale of the property herein granted and conveyed the said trustee is to receive five per centum for his trouble.
