 committee appointed by the Franklin Lodge No. 151, off. and ac-
 cepted Masons of the other part Witnesseth that Richard R. Barrett
 and Mary R. his wife, for the love they bear towards the Masonic
 Lodge, and Masonic Fraternity, doth grant and give to the Franklin
 Masonic Lodge No. 151. through the Committee above named, a
 lot of land in the village of Franklin containing ^{one acre}
 ing at a point on the main Street or road leading from the S. & R. R.
 Road towards the Steam boat wharf 10 feet from corner of said
 Road tract leading from S. & R. Road to wharf and 318 feet front
 of S. & R. R. Road and running thence Forty feet front and fifty
 feet Deep.
