

Drawing knife, 2 Iron Wedges, 4 Blaffle Irons, together with all other personal property or interest in any property he may have what ever. In trust however first one note due to Jas. J. Darden for Fifty Dollars due the 23rd day of November 1860, also for recording this deed after these payments are paid then to secure Jas. J. Darden in one note for Fifty Dollars and Ten cents due the 1st of January 1859, subject to a credit thirty seven cents, the 1st day of January 1859, also one other note due Jas. J. Darden for thirty one Dollars and seventy four cents due the 1st of Jan'y 1860, subject to a credit of Fifty cents the 1st of Jan'y 1860, also subject to another credit of Thirteen Dollars and fifty eight cents the 1st of January 1860, also a Store & Shop and this year due Jas. J. Darden for about twelve Dollars, also to secure one note to Parker D. Story for forty six Dollars and sixty seven cents due the 27th day of June 1859, also one note to Edwin R. Story for six Dollars and six cents due the 19th of December 1857, also one note due to E. R. Story for Fifty Dollars due the 16th of January 1859, also one note to E. R. Story for forty six Dollars & sixty seven cents due the 20th of June 1859, also one note to Miles Story for Twelve Dollars due the 23rd of Sept. 1858, also one note to Miles Story for forty six Dollars and sixty seven cents due the 8th of July 1859, also one note to Miles Story the 1st of January 1860 for Five Dollars & eighty cents. Then after all of the aforementioned debts are paid as they are described, then to secure all other debts that the said C. S. Story may owe to this date, if brought to do so, or to pay them in proportion as far as the residue may go, and the said Caled S. Story covenants that the said trustee shall at the request of J. J. Darden or either of the Storys mentioned in this Deed of trust after giving at least ten days notice of sale, sell at public auction for cash the aforesaid property, and then out of the proceeds pay the expenses of the sale then pay the debts as they are stipulated to be paid in this deed with the interest that may be on them and the surplus if any is to be paid over to the said Caled S.
