This Deed made this 1st day of December 1860, between Littleton R. Edwards of
the one part and Robert J. Fitch and Ann E., his wife, of the other part witnesseth; that whereas the said Robert J. Fitch and Ann E., his wife, by Deed bearing Date the
13th day of January 1859, and admitted to record on the same day, did convey unto the said Edwards
the following property to wit; a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of
Suffolk and containing Two hundred and seventy five acres more or less being the same
tract of land which the said Robert J. Fitch purchased of Jesse Little by Deed
admitted to record in the Clerk's office of Southampton County on the 20th day of
October 1856, also the following personal property to wit; the house one mile 60 head
of hogs, one yoke of Oxen, one Cow, and the future increase of said hogs &c. Also all his
household and kitchen furniture, and farming utensils. In trust to secure the payment
of a debt due to Jesse Little by bond executed by the said Robert J. Fitch of John M.
Gentry on the 20th day of October 1856. And whereas since the execution of the
said Deed the said Robert J. Fitch has fully paid off and discharged the debt aforesaid
due the said Jesse Little which he the said Little does hereby acknowledge. Now
therefore the said Littleton R. Edwards at the request of the said Robert J. Fitch
and by and with the consent and approbation of the said Jesse Little signified by his
signing these presents, and the said Jesse Little doth make and doth release
to the said Robert J. Fitch all their claims upon the said lands and other
property herein above mentioned.
