

Bounded as followeth to wit beginning at a Gum on the South side of the three Creeks then by a line of Mark Trees Viar a South Course to a Gum in a Small Branch then down the Branch to the Main Branch then running up the various Courses of the Main Branch to Hamans East Gate then by a line of Mark Trees as the path goes to the three Creeks Road then up the said Road to the line mentioned in the patent then along the S^d line to a white Oak aborn of Henry Joes Land then North one Hundred and fifty eight Pole to an ash then down the various Courses of the main run of the S^d Creek to the beginning all and Singular the Appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise Appertaining to have and to hold the S^d one hundred and ten acres of Land be the same more or less and promises to him the said John Joy his Heirs and Assigns forever to the only use and behoof of the said John Joy his Heir and Assigns forever And to and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever. This Indenture made the 15th Day of Novem^r in the year of our Lord Christ One Thousand and Seven Hundred and sixty Between James Ridley of the Parish of Notoway in the County of Southampton of the one part and Solomon Stephenson of the same parish and County Planter of the other part Witneseth that the said James Ridley for and in Consideration of the sum of one Hundred Pounds Currant Money of Virginia to him in Hand paid by the S^d Solomon Stephenson the receipt whereof he doth hereby Acknowledge and thereof acquit and Discharge the S^d Solomon Stephenson hath granted Bargained and Sold Aliened Enfeoffed and Confirmed by these Presents Doth Grant Bargain Sell Alien enfeoff and Confirm unto the said Solomon Stephenson his Heirs and Assigns forever one Tract or Parcel of Land Situate lying and being in the afo^r parish and County of Southampton and on the South side of the three Creeks Containing by Estimation one Hundred and Ninety six Acres be the same more or less which was purchased of Edmund Matthews by the S^d James Ridley and is bounded as followeth (To Wit) Beginning at a small Red Oak a line two of the Notoway Indians thence South to the main Road that leads from Smiths Bridge on the three Creeks to the Angolac Chaple thence up the various Courses of the
