This Indenture made this thirtieth Day of November in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven Hundred & sixty Between Hardy Pope of Southampton County of the one part & Simon Harris of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Hardy Pope for & in consideration of the Sum of Twenty Pounds Good & Lawfull money of Virginia to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof he doth hereby Acknowledge himself fully & Entirely satisfied & paid have bargained Sold aliened Enfeoffed and confirmed & by these Presents doth Bargain Sell alien Enfeoff and forever confirm unto the said Simon Harris his Heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcell of Land lying & being in the County of Southampton & Bounded as followeth Beginning at Gravelly run Branch thence up the stoney Pond Branch to Mathew Griffins Corner Tree which is a Gum in the s^d Branch thence along Mathew Charles line to a Pine in Gravelly Run Branch which is a Corner Tree & down the said Branch to stoney Pond Branch containing by Estimation one Hundred Acres more or less. To have to hold the said Land and Premises together with all Houses out Houses Gardens Orchards Woods Under Woods Mines and Minerals Marshes & low grounds & every part & parcell thereof unto him the said Simon Harris his Heirs Executors Administrators or assigns forever & the said Hardy Pope for himself his Heirs Executors & Administrators shall & will warrant the said Land & premises unto the said Simon Harris his Heirs &c. from all manner of persons laying any Claim by from or Under him In Witness whereof he the said Hardy Pope hath hereunto set his hand & seal the Day and
