the Receipt whereof the said Joseph Lark doth hereby Acknowledge and thereof Oath  
against the said Edward Matthews his Heirs Executors and Administrators Hath Granted  
Bargained Sold Alienated Released and Confirmed & by these Presents Doth Grant  
Bargain Alien Release Confirm unto the said Matthews his Heirs and Assigns  
forever one certain parcel or Dividend of Land Situate Lying and Being in the  
County aforesaid Containing by Estimation Two Hundred Acres of Land more or
