Sebrell This Indenture made this Twelveth Day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand
 Seven Hundred & forty one Between Benjamin Sebrell of the County of Southampton
 of the one part & Franklin Clark of the said County of the other Part witnesseth that the
 said Benjamin Sebrell for & in consideration of the sum of Twenty six pounds one Shilling
 Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid at or before the Within sealing and
 Delivery of these Presents the receipt whereof himself fully satisfies & contented and
 Said he doth hereby Acknowledge hath granted Bargained and sold Aliened &
 confirmed by these Presents doth grant Bargain sell alien & confirm unto the
 said Franklin Clark his Heirs & Assigns forever One certain Tract or Parcell of
 Land lying in the County aforesaid being the Land that Benjamin Purchas
 of Daniel Sebrell containing by estimation one hundred & fifty Acres more or less
 And Bounded according to the most known Ancient and repected Bounds thereof
 and all the Estate Right Title Interest Property Claim & Demand of him the said
 Benjamin Sebrell and his Heirs or in unto the said Land & Premises or any Part
 Thereof gall Houses Orchards Woods Waters & Water Courses Profits Commodities Adve
 ntages Hereditaments & Appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract or Parcell
 of Land belonging or in any Wise appertaining & the reversion & reversions Remainder
 and remainders Rents Issues and Profits thereof To have and to hold the said
 Tract or Parcell of Land and Premises with the appurtenances thereto let
 To the proper use and behoof of him the said Franklin Clark his heirs and assigns
 ongoing unto the said Franklin Clark his Heirs & Assigns forever & the said Benjamin
 Sebrell for himself his Heir & Exec & Adm^r do Covenant Promise Grant and
 agree to with the said Franklin Clark his Heirs & Assigns by these Presents that him
 the said Benjamin Sebrell shall & will from time to time and at all times for
 ever hereafter make do & execute or cause to be made done and executed all such further
 and other acts or acts thing and things diverses Conveyances & assurances in the Law
 whatsoever for the better and surer settling & confirming the said Land and
 Premises unto the said Clark his Heirs & Assigns also that he the said Benjamin
 Sebrell the said Land & Premises from himself & his Heirs from the claim
 of all other Persons & Persons unto the said Franklin Clark his Heirs
 & Assigns shall & will warrant & forever defend by these Presents In Witness whereof the
 parties to these Presents hath hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals the Day
