of the one Part and John Gilliam of the County of Southampton Merchant of the other
Part Witnesseth that for in Consideration of the sum of Three Hundred & Ten Pounds

Current Money of Virginia by the said John Gilliam to the said Henry Harrison in Hand
Paid at or before the Sealing & Delivery of these Presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby

acknowledge & thereof acquit & Discharge the said John Gilliam his heirs & assigns
forever by these Presents they the said Henry Harrison & Elizabeth his Wife Have Gra

nted Bargained Sold aliened Released & Consumed & by these Presents do each of them Doth
Grant Bargain sell alien Release & Confirm unto the said John Gilliam & his heirs & assigns

full All that Piece or Parcell of Land situate lying & being in the said County of Southampton
on the North side of the Raccoon Swamp containing three Hundred & ten Acres more or less

and Bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a small Gum in the run of the S^d Swamp then
running the M^dlers of the run of the said Swamp to the Bridge on the main Road leading

over that Swamp to Peter's Bridge then along the said Road to a small Branch then S^W by
pole to a Turkey Oak stump a corner tree between the said John Gilliam & the said Henry

Harrison then South four Hundred & six pole to the beginning with all Houses out houses
Edifices Buildings woods Ways Water Water courses Low Grounds Swamps profits Commodities

Hereditaments & Appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining
and the reversion & reversions Remainder & remainders Rents Issues & profits thereof & all
