Bob Sam Pat Jean Beech Brind Lin all & all my Personal Estate of what kind soever it consists to have & to hold all & singular the said Estate have bargained & sold & by these Presents doth bargain & sell unto the said Frederick Fort his Executors Administrators & assigns forever & the said Holliday Fort for myself my Executors & Administrators all & singular the said Estate unto the said Frederick Fort his Executors Administrators & assigns against me the said Holliday Fort my Executors administrators & assigns against all & every other Person & Persons whatsoever shall & will warrant & sever. I send by these Presents In Witness whereof I the said Holliday Fort have hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal this Fourteenth Day of January in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred & sixty one.
