This Indenture made this 12th Day of March in the Year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven Hundred & sixty one Between Samuel Eley & Mary his Wife of Southampton County of the one Part & Christopher Wade of the said County of the other Part. Witneeth the s^d Samuel Eley & Mary his Wife for in Consideration of the Sum of Twelve Pounds good & Lawfull Money of Virginia to them in hand paid the Receipt whereof they doth hereby Acknowledge themselves fully & entirely Satisfied and Paid have granted Bargained Sold Aliened Enfeoffed & confirmed & by these Presents doth Bargain sell Alien Enfeoffed & for ever confirm unto the s^d Christopher Wade his Heirs & Assigns forever One certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying in the East side of the Cypress Swamp in the County of Southampton & Bounded as followeth Beginning at a White Oak a Corner Tree of Samuel Eley from thence down a line of Francis Low to a Gum standing in the Cypress Swamp from thence up the s^d Swamp to a live Oak a Corner Tree from thence along a line of Marked Trees to a Pine Sapling a Corner Tree & from thence a straight Line to the first Station containing Fifty Acres more or less which Land is part of a Tract that Eley bought of Thomas Seaman of Henric County by Deed bearing Date the Ninth Day of August One Thousand seven Hundred & thirty six To have and to hold the said Land & Premises together with all Houses out Houses Gardens Orchards Woods Underwoods meadows Minerals Marshes & Low Grounds & every part & Parcel thereof unto him the s^d Christopher Wade his Heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns forever of the s^d Samuel Eley & Mary his Wife for them selves their Heirs Executors & Administrators that yet will warrant
