 said Chaplin Williams doth hereby acknowledge & himself to be therewith fully satisfied
 Contented & paid hath Granted Bargained sold Alien Released & Conferred by these presents
 doth Grant Bargain Sell Alien Release & Confirm unto the s^d Wootton his Heirs & assigns
 one certain Tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the County afores^d containing
 by Estimation two hundred & ninety Acres be the same more or less & bounded according to
 the most known Ancient & repeated Bounds thereof all the Estate Right Title Interest
 Property Claim & Demand of him the s^d Chaplin Williams & his Heirs of in or to the
 said Land & premises or any Part thereof & all Houses Orchards Woods Waters & Water Courses
 Profits Commodities Advantages Hereditaments & Appurtenances whatsoever to the s^d Tract
 or parcel of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining & the reversion & reversions Remain-
 der & Remainders Rent Issues & Profits thereof So have and to hold the s^d Tract or parcel
 of Land & Premises with the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the s^d John Wootton
 his Heirs & assigns to the only proper use & behoof of the s^d John Wootton his Heirs & assigns
