of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred sixty one Between Richard Kello of
the Parish of Nottoway & County of Southampton Gent & Mary his Wife of the one
Part & Henry Johnson of the afores^d Parish & County Taylor of the other Part Witnesses etc
that the s^r Richard Kello & Mary his Wife for & in Consideration of the Sum of forty
five Pounds Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the s^r Henry
Johnson the receipt whereof the s^r Richard Kello doth hereby acknowledge & thereof
Aquit & Discharge the s^r Henry Johnson his heirs Executors & Administrators by these
Presents have & each of them Hath Granted Bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed &
Confirmed & by these presents do & each of them Doth Grant Bargain Sell Alien-
Enfeoff & Confirm unto the s^r Henry Johnson & to his heirs assigns forever All that
Plantation Tract or parcel of Land situate lying & being in the Parish & County afores^d
Containing two hundred & ten Acres & bounded as followeth viz Beginning at a red
Oak a corner Tree of Dukas Land running thence North forty degrees East one hundred
fifty four Poles to a Pine standing in the New Pen Swamp a corner of Rich^d Vicks
Land & Stephen Johnson thence up the Meanders of the s^r Swamp to a Gum a corner
Tree of Rich^d Vicks Land thence along the s^r Vicks Line South forty seven degrees
West eighty Poles to a red Oak standing in the s^r Vicks Line thence South thirty
