This Indenture ^{made} the 4th Day of May One Thousand Seven Hundred sixty one
In the first Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord King George the Third between
Thomas Edwards of Southampton County on y^e one part & Jesse Edwards of the
Same County on the other Part Witnesseth that the s^d Tho^s Edwards for in Considera-
tion of the Sum of Ten pounds to him in hand paid by the a^ss^d Jesse Edwards
the receipt whereof the s^d Tho^s Edwards doth hereby Acknowledge himself fully satisfied
contented & Paid & therefore doth Acquit & Discharge the s^d Jesse Edwards his Heirs & Exors
Administrators & every of them by these Presents Hath Granted Alienated Bargained
Sold & Delivered and doth fully & clearly & absolutely give grant Alienate Bargain
sell & Deliver Inseparably confirm unto the s^d Jesse Edwards his Heirs & Exors Admin^{rs} and
Assigns for ever A Tract or Parcel of Land lying & being on the South side of the Main
Black water Swamp containing by Estimation One Hundred & Ten Acres more or
less the s^d Dividend of Land being Part of a Patent granted to Edward Goodson & Mathias
Rushin bearing Date the sixteenth Day of June One Thousand Seven hundred &
fourteen & bounded as followeth Viz^t Beginning at Hickory a Corner Tree of James
Bullocks Corner in Goodsons Patents line then along the s^d line to a Spanish Oak then
North Twenty four Degrees West fifty Pole to a red Oak then North Seventy six degrees
West thirty six Pole to a live Oak a little Below the Mouth of a Branch then up the s^d
Branch fifty six Poles to a Poplar then South seven degrees East one Hundred Pole to
a red Oak near Thompsons Swamp then along a line of Marked Trees to a white Oak
standing in the fork then down flaguen Swamp to the Mouth of a Branch
then up the s^d Branch to a Poplar & then to the first station Including one Hundred
& ten Acres more or less To have and to Hold the s^d Land & premises Clear of all
Charges that have been heretofore with the Appurtenances therunto belonging unto the
s^d Jesse Edwards his Heirs forever so that the s^d Tho^s Edwards his Heirs & Exors Admin^{rs}
