 s^t Co^t of Southampton containing one hundred & twenty Acres & Bounded as appears by a Deed
 from the Chief Men of the Nottoway Indians to the s^t Moses Branch Dated the fourth Day of
 April one Thousand seven hundred & forty three & Recorded in the Court of Isle of Wight Reference
 thereunto being had may more fully & clearly appear also all Woods Under Woods Ways Waters
 Water Courses & with all Profits Commodities & Advantages whatsoever to the same belonging
