This Indenture made this Twenty fifth Day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand
 Seven Hundred & sixty one Between James Pope of Virginia & County of Southampton of
 the one Part and John Pope of the same County of the other Part Witneeth that thes^t
 s^t Pope for in Consideration of the Sum of Sixteen pounds Current Money to him in
 hand Paid at or before the Ensigning & Delivery hereof the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknow-
 ledged of thes^t John Pope thereof he thes^t s^t Pope doth hereby Acquit and Discharge
 hath Granted Bargained Sold and by these doth fully & absolutely grant Bargain
 Sell Enfeoff and Confirm unto thes^t John Pope his Heirs & Assigns one Certain Tract
 or Parcel of Land lying & being in Southampton County on the South Side of Nottoway
 River containing by Estimation one hundred & fifty Acres be the same more or less and
 bounded as followeth Beginning at a Black Oak standing near the Road that leads
 from Flowers Bridge on Nottoway River to Grasslands Bridge on Meherin then along
 Col^l Edmunds line to a Slightwood Swamp standing near the Road called the Chappell
 Road then down thes^t Chappell Road to Flowers Road then down the s^t Flowers
 Road to the Beginning together with all Houses & Buildings thereon with the
 Reversion & Reversions Remainder & Remainders Rents Issues & Profits thereof &
 every Part and Parcel thereof with the Appurtenances To have and to hold all &
 Singular thes^t Land above Mentioned & every Part & Parcel thereof unto thes^t John
 Pope his Heirs & Assigns forever of thes^t s^t Pope for himself his Heirs & Assigns
 thes^t Land & Premises & every Part thereof agst all & every other Person or Persons
 whatsoever to thes^t John Pope his Heirs & Assigns shall & will warrant & forever
 Defend by these Presents in Witneess whereof thes^t s^t Pope hath hereunto set his
 hand & affixed his Seal the day & year above Written
