 Part Witnesseth that the s^d Edw Doyle for an in consideration of the sum of five
 Pounds ten Shillings Curr^t money of Virginia the s^d Edw Doyle in hand Paid by the s^d
 John Bennet jr at or before the in sealing and Delivery of these Presents the receipt whereof
 the s^d Edw Doyle do Acknowledge and thereof Acquit and Discharge the s^d John Bennet
 hath granted Bargained and Sold Aliened in seoffed and confirmed and by these Presents
 do grant bargain and Sell alien in seoff and confirm unto the s^d John Bennet to him his
 heirs and assigns forever All that Tract or Parcel of Land situate lying and being in the
 afo^r County of Southampton containing one hundred and twenty five Acres more or
 less and bounded as followeth Viz Beginning at a white Oak in Edw Doyle
 line formerly Martin Harris thence along the s^d Edw Doyle line to a white Oak a
 corner tree standing by the side of a Slack thence along the s^d line to a line a corner tree
