Greeting Whereas Alexander Murray & Mary his Wife of the County of Brunswich by their Certain Indenture of Bargain Sale bearing Date the Eleventh Day of December 1760 have Sold and Conveyed unto Jephthah Atherton of the City of Southampton the Fee simple Estate and Inheritance of and in one certain Tract or Parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid on the side of Warrens Branch containing two hundred ^{and fifty} Acres or thereabouts And Whereas the said Mary cannot conveniently Travel to the Court of our said County of Southampton to make acknowledgment of the said Conveyance Therefore We do give unto you or any two or more of you Power to receive the Acknowledgment which the said Mary shall be willing to make of the Conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereunto annexed And We do therefore Command you or any two of you that you do Personally go to the said Mary and Examine her privily and apart from the said Alexander her Husband Whether she doth the same freely and Voluntarily without the persuasion or threats of the said Alexander her Husband and Whether she is willing the same should be Recorded in the Court of our said County of Southampton And when you have received the Acknowledgment and Examined her as aforesaid that you distinctly and Plainly Certifie us thereof under your Seals enclosed returned also unto us the said Indenture and this Writ Witness Richard Hells Clerk of our said Court at the Courthouse the twentieth Day of December In the thirty fourth year of our Reign
