This Indenture made this 13th Day of August one thousand seven hundred and sixty
one Between Joshua Rochester and Patience his Wife of Hartford County in the
Province of North Carolina of the one Part and Arthur Vick of the County of Southampton
and Colony of Virginia of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Joshua Rochester for
Consideration of the Sum of twenty four Pounds Curr^t Money of Virginia to him in hand
paid Arthur Vick at or before the Sealing and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof
the said Joshua Rochester doth hereby Acknowledge He the said Joshua Rochester hath
granted bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed and by these Presents doth grant bargain
sell enfeoff & confirm unto the said Arthur Vick his Heirs & assigns forever a certain Tract
