 between the western Boundary of their s^d Tract and Buckhorn Swamp on the South side
 of Nottoway River in the s^d County of Southampton as that Part of their s^d Lands lying on the East
 side of the s^d Swamp and the South of Buckhorn Swamp to the Eastern and Southern Boundary
 thereof containing about five Thousand Acres for the best Price that could be got and after any
 Agreement made for the Sale of the same or any Part thereof it is by the s^d Act declared lawful for
 the Chief Men of the said Nation together with the Trustees aforesaid or the Survivors or Survivor
 of them to Seal and Deliver any Deeds or Deeds indented for the conveyance of the Fee simple and
 Intendence of the s^d Land to the Purchaser upon his entering into Bond with good Security
 for the Payment of the Purchase Money to the said Trustees for the Use and Purpose in the said
 Act expressed and whereas the s^d John Edmunds for the Consideration of Thirty Pounds
 Curr^t Money for Payment whereof to the s^d Trustees for the Use aforesaid he hath entered into
 Bond with good Security / hath Purchased two Hundred & fifty two Acres part of the said Tract
 of five thousand Acres of Land of the s^d Chief Men of the s^d Indian Nation with Consent and
 Approbation of the s^d Trustees Bounded as followeth to wit / Beginning at a Pine a
 Corner of N^o 12 thence North East one Hundred & Seventy four Poles to a Pine a Corner of N^o 12
 thence North West two hundred and Seventy two Poles to a small Sweet Gum in Blunt
 Swamp thence Down the Meadows of the said Swamp to a White Oak Corner to Col^d
 Howell Edmunds thence South twenty Degrees East one hundred & Sixty Poles to a Spanish
 Oak another Corner of the s^d Edmunds thence South eight Degrees West thirty eight
 Poles to a Red Oak another Corner of the s^d Edmunds thence South East one Hundred and
 forty to the Beginning Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the s^d Chief
 Men of the s^d Indian Nation with the Consent & Approbation of the s^d Justices
 Testified by there being made Parties to these Presents for and in Consideration of the said
 sum of thirty Pounds secured to be paid as aforesaid. Have granted bargained & sold
 aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these Presents Do grant bargain & sell alien
 enfeoff release and confirm unto the said John Edmunds his Heirs & assigns
 the s^d two Hundred & fifty two Acres part of the s^d Tract of five thousand Acres of
 Land as above to be sold and also the Reversion & reversions Remainder and
 Remainders Tenths & Services thereof and also the Estate right Title Interest Property
 Claim & Demand whatsoever of the s^d Nation and their Posterity of in and to the
 same To have and to hold the s^d two hundred and fifty two Acres of Land with
 the appurtenances unto the said John Edmunds his Heirs and assigns to the only proper
 Use & behoof of the s^d John Edmunds his Heirs & assigns forever In Witness
