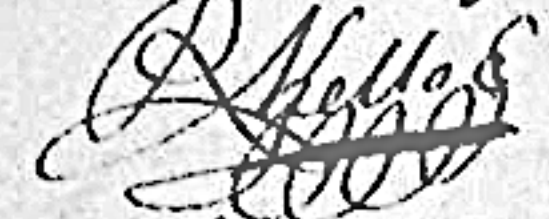

were Personally Present Ratifying & by these Presents allowing all and whatsoever my s^d Attorneys shall
in my Name Lawfully do or cause to be done in and about the Premises by Virtue of these Presents
