This Indenture made the seventh Day of October in the first year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the third by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c and in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & sixty one Between John Hines of the City of Southampton Parish of Vottoway of the one Part and W^m Hines of the City and Parish of the other Part Witnesseth that the said John Hines for and in Consideration of the Sum of ten Pounds Curr^t Money of Virginia to him in hand Paid at or before the sealing & Delivery of these Presents the Receipt of which and himself fully satisfied Contented and Paid he doth hereby acknowledge have granted Bargained and Sold Aliened Enfeoffed Released & Confirmed and by these Presents Doth give grant Bargain & Sell alien Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said W^m Hines his Heirs and Assigns forever a certain Plantation Tract or Parcel of Land whereon the said W^m Hines now Dwelleth containing one hundred Acres be the same more or less and Bounded as Followeth Beginning at the Mouth of a Branch at the Afternoon Swamp then running up the Courses of the said Branch to the head near the main Road then along a line of Market Trees to a Red Oak in the said Line which Divides the said Land from Thomas Hines then from that Red Oak which is made a Corner by a line of Market Trees to a Red Oak Sapling in John Hines Jun^r Line then along the said John Hines Jun^r line to the Road afo^r then along the said Road to a Black Oak a Corner then by a line of Market Trees to a line in a Pond then Down a Valle to the Head of a Small Branch Between the said Land and the said John Hines Plantation then down the said Branch to the Afternoon Swamp afo^r then up the Various Courses of the run of the said Swamp to the Beginning & all all Woods Under Woods ways waters water Courses all Profits Commodities and Advantages whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise Appertaining and also the Reversions Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rent & Services of the Premises and every Part thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest Claim and Demand whatsoever of him the said John Hines of in and to the same premises and every part thereof To have and to Hold all and Singular the said Premises above mentioned and every Part and Parcel thereof with the Appurtenances unto the said W^m Hines his Heirs and Assigns to the only Proper Use and
