 Race Jun^r of Southampton City of the other Part Witnesseth that the s^d William
 Wormack Jun^r for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Pounds Curr^t Money of Eng^l to him in
 hand Paid by the s^d Joseph Race Jun^r at and before the Sealing & Delivery of these Presents the Receipt
 whereof the said W^m Wormack Jun^r doth hereby Acknowledge he the s^d W^m Wormack Jun^r
 hath granted Bargained and Sold Aligned Enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these Presents doth
 grant Bargain Sell Alien Enfeoff and Confirm unto the s^d Joseph Race his Heirs and assigns
 forever A Certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing one hundred & Fifty Acres Being a Tract
 of Land granted to the s^d W^m Wormack Jun^r by Patent bearing Date the Fifth Day of March
 one thousand Seven Hundred & forty Seven lying and being in the County of Southampton
 on the north side of Meherin River and Bounded as Followeth to wit Beginning at a
 small Black Oak a corner of Edward Lundy's Land then by the s^d Lundy's Line South
 seventy Degrees West forty Poles to a Lightwood Post a corner of W^m Wormack Sen^r Land thence
 by the s^d W^m Wormack Sen^r Land North fifty Degrees West Sixty Four Poles to a Red Oak North
 fifty Degrees West Forty Poles to a White Oak a corner of John Nanny's Land
 thence by the s^d Nanny's Lines North Forty Degrees East Fifty six Poles to a White Oak and
