 hundred & sixty one Between John Collier of the County of Surry of the one Part & John Mecom of the County
 of Sole of Whight of the other Part Witnesseth that the said John Collier for good Consideration
 of the sum of one hundred and thirty five Pounds Curr^t. Money of Virginia to him in hand
 paid by the s^d John Mecom before the sealing and Delivery hereof the Receipt whereof the
 s^d John Collier doth hereby Acknowledge and by these Presents grant Bargain and Sell
 unto the s^d John Mecom two hundred and seventy Acres of Land lying and being in the
 City of Southampton & on the Aspmoosock Swamp To Wit. two hundred & twenty Acres
 of the s^d Land being given by his Grandfather Thomas Collier was Patented by the said
 Tho. Collier bearing Date the first Day of April one thousand seven hundred and seventy
 and the other ~~two~~ Fifty Acres the s^d John Collier did Patent twentieth Day of July
 in one thousand seven hundred and thirty eight the s^d Land the said John Collier hath
 granted Bargained and Sold ^{Doth} by these Presents grant bargain and Sell unto the said John
 Mecom his Heirs & Assigns forever a certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying & being in the City
 of Southampton and on the Aspmoosock as aforesaid and sold for two hundred & seventy
 Acres more or less which s^d Land was given & bequeathed by the last will & Testament
 of Thomas Collier bearing Date the one thousand seven hundred and twenty five
 which was also duly Acknowledged & Recorded in the City Court aforesaid Relation & being
 thereto had may more fully and at large appear and be bounded as followeth Beginning
 at a white Oak on the East side of the Aspmoosock Swamp a line Tree of the Nottoway Indian
 Lands thence Along the s^d Indians Line to the next Station & from thence to the Causeway
 & Down the Various Courses to Tho. Collier Line & down the s^d Tho. Colliers line to the Aspmoosock
 and all the Commodities Advantages & the Reversion & Reversions Remainder and Remainders
 Rights Issues & Profits thereof & all the Estate Right Title Interest Property Claim and Demand
 whatsoever of him the s^d John Collier & his Heirs & in case of there being any Defraud in
 the Right of the s^d Land I will oblige my Self my Heirs & Assigns to pay any Sum whatsoever
 unto the s^d John Mecom his Heirs and Assigns & will warrant & forever Defend against
 every & all Persons what soever by these Presents In Witness whereof the s^d John Collier
