This Indenture made this twentieth Day of May In the first Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the third now King of Great Britain &c And in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & sixty one Between Thomas Holliday of the Parish of in the City of Mansermonds Gent and Mary his Wife and John Drew of the same Parish Gent & Patience his Wife of the one Part and William Haynes of the Parish of Nottoway in the County of Southampton Gent of the other Part Whereas one Thomas Brewer late of the City of Mansermonds Gent deceased was in his lifetime & at the time of his Death seized & possessed in Fee of & in a certain Plantation Tractor Parcel of Land situate in the s^d County of Southampton Commonly called Quin Duars containing one thousand & ninety eight Acres or thereabouts & being so seized departed this Life having first made his last will & Testament in writing bearing Date the twenty
