& Discharge the s^d W^m Haynes his Heirs & Assigns by these Presents and for divers
other good Causes therein therein to moving they the s^d Tho^s Holliday & Mary his
Wife & John Drew & Patience his wife Have and each of them Have Granted Bargained
Sold Yielded up Surrendered remised Released & quit claimed & by these Presents Do and
each of them Doth Grant Bargain Sell yield up Surrender Remise Release & quit
claim unto the s^d W^m Haynes & to his Heirs & Assigns forever All that the s^d Tho^s
Holliday & Mary his Wife & John Drew and Patience his Wife theirs either of
them Estates Right Title Interest Claim & Demands whatsoever either in Possession
Reversion or ^{Remainder} ~~Reversion~~ or otherwise howsoever but more Especially the Reversion in
Fee simple after the Death of the s^d W^m Haynes of in & to that Plantation Tract or
Parcel of Land lying & being in the Parish of Vottorway in the City of Southampton on the
South side of Blackwater Swamp called Quin Luan containing one thousand and
ninety eight Acres being the Lands so as afo^r devised by the s^d Tho^s Brewer de^d to
his Daughter Julian the same being now in the Actual Possession of the s^d W^m
Haynes as Tenant by the Curtesie of England by Virtue of his intermarriage with
the s^d Julian To have and to hold the s^d Plantation Tract or Parcel of Land &
Premises with the Appurtenances unto the s^d W^m Haynes and to his Heirs & Assigns
To the only proper Use & behoof of the s^d W^m Haynes his Heirs & Assigns
forever And the s^d Tho^s Holliday & Mary his Wife & John Drew & Patience his
Wife for themselves their Heirs & Assigns do Covenant Promise & grant to and with the
s^d W^m Haynes his Heirs and Assigns by these Presents that they
