Greeting Whereas Thomas Holladay of the Parish of Suffolham the County of
Newsmond Gent & Mary his Wife & John Drew of the same Parish & City Gent &
Patience his Wife have by their certain Indenture of Release bearing Date the 2nd
Day of May 1761 Sold and Released unto William Haynes of the Parish of Nottoway
in the City of Southampton Gent the Reversion in Fee simple of one certain
Tract or Parcel of Land Situate lying & being in the Parish of Nottoway & City of
Southampton on the South side of Blackwater Swamp commonly called Lwin
Luan containing one thousand and ninety Eight Acres or there abouts And Whereas
the s^d Mary & Patience cannot conveniently Travel to our Court of Southampton
to make Acknowledgment of the said Conveyance thereof we do give you or any two
of you Power to Receive the Acknowledgment the s^d Mary and Patience shall be
willing to make before you of the Conveyance aforesaid contained in the aforesaid
Indenture which is hereto annexed and we do therefore Command you or any
two of you that you do Personally go to the s^d Mary and Patience & examine them
Privily and apart from the said Thomas & John their Husbands whether they do
the same freely & Voluntarily without the Persuasion or Threats of their s^d Husbands
whether they be willing the same should be Recorded in the Court of our said City
of Southampton & when you have Received their Acknowledgment & Examined them
as afo^r that you distinctly & Plainly Certifie us thereof under y^r Seals enclosed Returning
also unto us the s^d Indenture & this writ Witness Richard Kello Clerk of our said
Court at the Courthouse the twenty first Day of May 1761 In the first year
of our Reign
