Witnesseth that for in Consideration of the Sum of thirty two Pounds Curr^t
Money of Virginia by the s^d John Landford to me the s^d Henry Turner well & truly
in hand Paid at & before the Ensigning & Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof
Dorothy Acknowledged & every Part parcel thereof acquit Exonerate & Discharge the s^d
John Landford his Heirs & Assigns by these Presents to the s^d Henry Turner
hath given granted Bargained Sold Enfeoffed & confirmed & by these Presents with
fully Clearly & Absolutely Give grant Bargain Sell Alien Enfeoff & confirm unto
the s^d John Landford his Heirs & Assigns forever one certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing
by Estimation one hundred & fifty Acres be the same more or less & bounded as followeth
Beginning at the mouth of Black Creek Running up Black Water to the
mouth of a Branch to a White Oak a Corner tree of Joshua Witneys Land Then
along Witneys line to a Pine a Corner Tree then Down a straight line to Black Creek
to a Maple a Corner Tree then Down the Various Courses of the Creek to the first
Station together with all woods Underwoods ways water Water Courses Hereditaments
and Appurtenances whatsoever to the s^d Piece or Parcel of Land belonging or in any wise
Appertaining & the Reversion & Reversions Remainders & Remainders of all & singular
the before mentioned Premises or of any Part or Parcel thereof & all the Estate Right
Title Interest Property Claim & Demand whatsoever of him the s^d Henry Turner
of in or to the same To have and to Hold the s^d Piece or Parcel of Land and
Premises all & singular other the Premises hereby Granted unto the s^d John

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
