This Indenture Tripartite made the eleventh Day of April in thirty third Year of the Reigne of our Sovereign Lord King George the second and in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & thirty one Between George Skipper Jack Will Robbin Scholar and William Pearce Chief Men of the Nottoway Indian Nation of the first part Joseph Gray Howell Edmundo & William Taylor Gent of the County of Southampton of the
