of his Present Majesty's Reign Instituted an Act to enable the Nottoway Indians
to Sell Certain Lands & for other Purposes therein mentioned It is among other Things
Enacted That the Chief of the Nottoway Nation be & they are thereby empowered to Sell
Certain Lands therein mentioned by & with the Consent & Approbation of the said
Joseph Gray Howell Edmunds & W^m Taylor at a credit not exceeding twelve Months
and convey the same for the best Price that could be got & after any agreement made
for the same or any Part thereof it should & might be Lawful for the Chief Men of the
Nottoway Nation together with the s^d Joseph Gray Howell Edmunds & W^m Taylor their Trustees
to execute any Deed or Deeds indented for the conveyance of the Fee Simple and
Inheritance of the s^d Lands to the Purchasers who should give Bond & Security
for the Payment of the Purchase Money to the s^d Trustees And any Deed or
Deeds so executed & Perfected and Acknowledged or Proved & Recorded according to
the Direction of the s^d Act should be sufficient to Pass the Fee Simple Estate
of the s^d Lands so sold to the Purchaser as by the s^d in Part recited Act of
Assembly more fully is contained. Now this Indenture Witnesseth
that the s^d George Shipper Jack Will Robbin Scholar & W^m Pearce Chief Men of the
Nottoway Indian Nation and the s^d Joseph Gray Howell Edmunds & W^m Taylor
for in Consideration of the Sum of one Hundred two Pounds ten Shillings to the s^d
Joseph Gray Howell Edmunds & W^m Taylor in hand Paid by the s^d Miles Cary
at or before the Sealing & Delivery of these Presents for the Use of the s^d Nottoway
Indian Nation the Receipt whereof they do hereby Acknowledge & thereof
acquit & Discharge the s^d Miles Cary his Heirs Executors & Admors They the s^d
George Shipper Jack Will Robbin Scholar & W^m Pearce Chief Men of the
Nottoway Indian Nation and the s^d Joseph Gray Howell Edmunds & W^m Taylor
Have Granted Bargained Sold Alien'd Released and Confirmed and by these
Presents Do Grant Bargain Sell Alien Release & Confirm unto the s^d Miles
Cary his Heirs & assigns forever five Hundred & twenty Acres of Land lying
being in the Parish of Nottoway & City aforesaid and Denoted in the Surveyors
Platts of the Indian Land lately made by Number 384 and Bounded as
followeth Beginning at a black Oak Corner of N^o 1 on Buckhorn Road
thence up the Various Courses of the s^d Road to a black Oak Corner of the
Williamson's Land thence along a line of Mark's Trees to a Hickory

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
