This Indenture made the tenth Day of Dec^r in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred
 and sixty one in the first year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the third by the Grace of
 God of Great Britain France & Ireland King Defender of the Faith Witnesseth that I Hardy
 Johnson of Southampton City in the Province of Virginia for the Love & good Will I bear unto
 my Son Hardy Johnson & for the Consideration of the Sum of Ten Shillings to me in hand
 by the s^d Hardy Johnson my Son the Receipt whereof I hereby Acknowledge I the s^d Hardy
 Johnson Son do give grant confirm & make over unto the s^d Hardy Johnson just one hundred and
 Fifty Acres of Land to him & his Heirs forever Situate in Southampton City & Parish of Nottonway
 and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a white Oak at W^m Drakes Line running a
 Crope from a white Oak to a Black Oak the Corner of John Drakes Land to a pine a corner
 of Tho. Berries Land thence along the s^d Berries Line to a Gum standing in the South Line
 of the Peedy Branch that line in Tho. Drakes Line thence along the s^d Drakes Line
 to the above mentioned white Oak & I the s^d Hardy Johnson Son shall & will warrant and
