I know all men by these Presents that I Samuel Tomkins of York County for and in Consideration of the natural Love & Affection that I have and unto my three Grandchildren namely Mary Arrington Martha Sandefur & Anne Sandefur Daughters of W<sup>m</sup> Sandefur decd of Southampton County Have Given & Granted and by these Presents Doth Give & Grant unto the said Mary Arrington Martha Sandefur & Anne Sandefur and their heirs the following Slaves to wit Sary Hasty & Abram Children of the said Sary together with the Increase that shall be during the Life of my Daughter Mary Hasty reserving to my said Daughter Mary Hasty the use of the said Slaves together with their Increase during her natural Life to be Equally divided amongst them at the Death of my said Daughter Mary To have & to hold the said Slaves with their future Increase at the Term above mentioned unto the said Mary Arrington Martha Sandefur & Anne Sandefur and their Heirs for ever In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 11<sup>th</sup> Day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & sixty one
