This Indenture made the tenth Day of Febr^y in the year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred and forty two Between Lewis Joyner and Martha Wife
 of the City of Southampton of the one Part & Joshua Grose of thes^e City of the other Part
 Witnesses that the s^d Lewis Joyner and Martha his Wife for in Consideration of
 the Sum of five Pound Curr^t Money of Virginia to here in hand Paid by thes^e
 Joshua Grose the Receipt whereof the s^d Lewis Joyner & Martha his Wife do the
 hereby Acknowledge. That he granted bargained & sold aliened Enfeoffed & Confirmed
 and by these Presents Doth grant bargain and Sell alien Enfeoff and Confirm
 unto thes^e Joshua Grose his Heirs & assigns forever one certain Tract or Parcel of
 Land lying in Southampton City and on the North Side of Notterway Thway
 Containing Severally five Acres let the same be more or less the s^d Divided of
 Land being Part of a Patent Granted to Lewis Joyner bearing Date the fourteenth
 Day of Febr^y 1761 and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a Pine Sapling
 in Charles Coltharps Line & thence Running thes^e Line to Red Oak a Corner Tree of
 thes^e Coltharps and thence to a Pine a Corner Tree of thes^e Coltharps and thence
 Joyner and thence by thes^e Joyners Line to a Red Oak a Corner Tree of thes^e Joyners Line
 and Nicholas Williams & thence by a Line of Marked Trees to the Beginning
 with all Woods and Under Woods Common & Commons of Pastures Profits Commodities
 Advantages Emoluments & Hereditaments whatsoever to the Plantation or Tract
 of Land Belonging or in any way Appertaining or upon the same growing
