This Indenture made this thirteenth Day of May in the second year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George the third by the Grace of God of Great Britain France & Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c. and in the 12th year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & sixty two Between Solomon Stephenson of the Parish of Nottonway & City of Southampton of the one Part & Timothy Sharpe of the same Parish & City of the other Part Witnesseth that the sd Solomon Stephenson for in Consideration of the sum of twenty seven Pounds current Money of Virginia to him in hand Paid by the sd Timothy Sharpe the Receipt whereof the sd Solomon Stephenson doth hereby acknowledge & being acquitted & discharged the sd Timothy Sharpe his Heirs Executors & Assigns by these Presents hath Granted Bargained & sold aliened released & confirmed by these Presents doth Grant Bargain & sell alien release & confirm unto the sd Timothy Sharpe his Heirs & Assigns all that Plantation Tract or Parcel of Land finally lying & being in the Parish and City aforesaid on the south side of the three acres containing by Estimation one hundred & twenty five acres be the same more or less Bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a small Red Oak a fine Tree of the Nottonway Indians thence South to the Main Road that leads from Smiths Bridge to the Angelica Chappel thence up the various Courses of the sd Road to the sd Road's upper line crosses the sd Road thence as the line is directed by Pattern bearing Date the thirteenth Day of Jan^r one thousand seven hundred & sixty three including all the Land on the East Side of the sd Road in the sd Pattern the sd Plantation Tract or Parcel of Land being Purchased by the sd Solomon Stephenson of the sd Timothy Sharpe by Indenture bearing Date the 15th Day of Nov^r 1760 reference being thereunto had may

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
