This Indenture made this twelfth Day of August In the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred & sixty and in the second year of his Maj: Reign Breten Joseph Larke of Nottonary Parish in the County of Southampton of the one part and Henry Applenwright of the Parish & City of of the other part Witneseth that the sd Larke for and in consideration of the sum of thirty Pounds Curr: Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the sd Henry Applenhaite before the ^{including} Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof the sd Jos. Larke doth Confess and Acknowledge for himself his Heirs & Assigns or assigns thereof every of them and doth Acquit Discharge by these Presents Heath granted Bargained & sold in possession and doth confirm the same unto Henry Applenwright his Heirs & Assigns one Tract or Parcel of Land containing three hundred & seven Acres or more as may appear by a Patent granted the sd Larke of the Hon^{ble} Francis Fauquier Baring Date the twenty fifth Day of March 1762 and in the second year of our said reign situate lying & being in the City of Southampton North side the three Creeks and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a Maple by the side of the Weedy Branch John Wiggins Corner thence South thirty nine degrees West two hundred and forty eight Pole to a white Oak the sd Henry Applenwright Timothy Sharpes Corner Thence North ^{Twenty} Eighty eight Degrees west one hundred & twenty four Pole to a Pine Timothy Thorns Corner thence North sixty one Degrees West nineteen Pole to a bed Oak thence South thirty five Degrees west seventy two Poles to a bed Oak another Corner of the sd Thorns thence North fifty five Degrees West forty eight Pole to a Lightwood Post Edw^d Hanip's Corner thence North thirty nine Degrees East one hundred Pole to the Weedy Branch aforesaid and down the various Courses of the Corn of the sd Branch to the Beginning
