This Indenture made the 10 day of November in the first year of the reign
 of our sovereign lord George the third by the grace of god of great Britain France &
 Ireland King defender of the faith &c and in the year of our lord god one thousand seven
 hundred and sixty two. Between David Edwards of Southampton county and
 Lathorn Edwards his wife of the one part and William Wester of the same county
 of the other part Witneseth that the said David Edwards and Lathorn Edwards
 his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one pound fifteen shillings current
 money of him in hand paid by the said W^m Wester at and before the sealing and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said David Edwards and Lathorn
 his wife doth hereby acknowledge he the said David Edwards and Lathorn his wife hath
 granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain
 and sell alien enfeof and confirm unto the said W^m Wester his heirs and assigns forever
 one certain parcel of Land containing by estimation ten acres part of a patent granted to James
 Edwards for three hundred & forty acres by the honorable S^r William Gooch his Majesty's
 Lieutenant Governor in chief of the colony of Virginia and bounded according to the
 patent beginning at a red oak a corner tree dividing Lazarus Colles land and W^m
 Westers then N^o East to a live oak standing in the center of the broad neck branch
 account tree a dividing line between David Edwards and Lazarus Colles and then N^o East
 to a sweet gum a corner tree dividing William Westers land and James Gardners
 on the parcel then from the sweet gum southwest to a hickory a corner tree
 between W^m Westers and James Gardner & from hickory west to the beginning
