Gooch Esq. our Lieutenant Governor the twentieth day of September 1745. relation therunto will more fully and at large appear Beginning at a corner tree a lightwood stump of Christopher Wades line & thence along the said line to a black oak a corner tree of John Sawrances & thence down the said line to a corner tree of John Joyners thence the said line to a kitchen a corner tree

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
