 Grant bargain sell and alien convey and confirm unto the said Tho. Sankford Sen.
 his heirs and assigns or assigns one messuage tract or parcel of land lying and being in
 Southampton county and province aforesaid on the south side of black water swamp
 it being a parcel of land that the said Whitney left in his last will and testament to
 be sold to the said Sankford containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres more
