This Indenture made this 12 day of May 1763 Between James Harris
and Cherry Boydin both of the county of Halifax in the province of North
Carolina of the one part and Benjamin Arrington of the county of Southampton
in the Colony of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Harris
and Cherry Boydin for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & thirty pounds
current money of Virginia to him in hand paid at or before the executing & delivery of these
presents the receipt of which and himself fully satisfied contented and paid he doth hereby
acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents
doth give grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said Benj^r Arrington his
heirs and assigns forever all that plantation tract of Land lying and being in the county of
Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation three hundred and sixty acres more
less and bounded as followeth Beginning at a live oak on the east side of the Appomattock
swamp thence East four hundred and two pole to a red oak thence north one hundred
and sixty pole to three trees chopt in woods thence west four hundred thirty pole to a large
oak by the side of the Appomattock swamp and down the various courses of the run of the
run of the said swamp to the beginning being conveyed to James Harris dead by a deed
from the chief men of the northern Indians bearing date the seventh day of August
1700 and seven hundred & thirty five also all woods and crooked ways water courses
courses with all profit commodities and advantages whatsoever to the same belonging in
anywise appertaining and also the reversion and reversionary remainder and
services of the said premises and of every part thereof and also all the title right
title interest claim or demand whatsoever of the said James Harris & Cherry Boydin of the
the same premises and every part thereof To have and to hold all and singular the
said premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with their appurtenances
unto the said Benj^r Arrington his heirs and assigns forever To the only proper use
and behoof of the said Benj^r Arrington his heirs and assigns forever and the said James
Harris and Cherry Boydin for themselves their heirs do the above mentioned premises
and every part thereof give them their heirs and assigns all and every other person of persons
whatsoever to the said Benjamin Arrington his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant
and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said James Harris
