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This Indenture made the eighth day of June one thousand seven hundred and sixty three Between Joseph Reese Jr. of Southampton County of the one part & Joseph Reese Jr. of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joseph Reese Jr. for and in consideration of the sum of forty one pounds current money of Virginia in hand paid by the said Jos. Reese Jr. at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Jos. Reese Jr. doth hereby acknowledge to the said Joseph Reese Jr. hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Jos. Reese Jr. his heirs and assigns forever. A certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred acres more or less situate lying and being on the north of Metherin River in county aforesaid and bounded as follows/ to wit/ Beginning at a small red Oak in Edward Lundy's line thence south eighty two degrees east sixty nine pole to a maple then north South by east eighty nine pole to a Gum over the path to a line tree of James Reddy's lot. Land thence by Reddy's line north fifty degrees west twenty five pole to a small live Oak & then south ten degrees east forty nine pole to a hickory then north west by west sixty four pole to a live Oak then south seventy two degrees west ninety five pole to a live Oak a line tree of Timothy's Thorne Land then by Thorne's line south fifty five degrees east five pole to a red Oak south fifty degrees east one hundred nine pole to a hickory thence along a line of market trees Between David Lundy and the said Jos. Reese Jr. to the Beginning. And also all trees woods underwoods commons common of pastures profits Commodities advantages emoluments & Hereditaments to the said land above mentioned belonging or in any wise appertaining or in upon the same happening growing or arising and also the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rent and services of the said premises and every part thereof. And also all this estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Jos. Reese Jr. or in or to the same
