This Indenture made the 11 day of August one thousand seven hundred & forty three Between John Blythe and Charity his wife of the one part and Joshua Council of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Blythe & Charity his wife for and in consideration of the sum of eleven pounds current money of Virginia by the said Joshua Council in hand paid at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Blythe and Charity his wife do then by acknowledge acquit and discharge the said Joshua Council his heirs executors and administrators forever by these presents they the said John Blythe & Charity his wife hath granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said Joshua Council and his heirs and assigns forever all that tract plantation tract or parcel of land whereon the said Joshua Council now lives situate lying and being in the parish of netterway and containing by estimation seventy five acres be the same more or less it being part of a patent of two hundred & fifty acres granted to Thomas Drake the first day of September one thousand seven hundred thirty three by Hugh Downs then Lieutenant Governor and commander in chief of the said Colony and Dominion of Virginia and since transferred by divers deeds & conveyances. It also more fully and at large appears into paper of the said John Blythe & Charity his wife who hath an absolute right to dispose of the same and bounded as followeth beginning at a white oak standing on a path called Scotts path and from thence along a line of marked trees of Thomas Bishops land and from thence along a line of marked trees being Timothy Drakes line to a pine tree a corner standing near the upper end of the aforesaid Scotts path and from thence down the said path to the first station and all houses out houses edifices buildings woods wastes waters courses profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents issues profits thereof and all the whole right title and interest of him the said John Blythe & Charity his wife in and to the same and every part thereof To have and to hold the said plantation tract and acreage of seventy five acres of land as aforesaid unto the said Joshua Council and his heirs forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Joshua Council and his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Blythe and Charity his wife and their heirs the said land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said Joshua Council and his heirs and assigns against him the said John Blythe & Charity these presents In Witness whereof the said John Blythe and Charity his wife hath hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year above written
