Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Thomas Gray for the consideration of And also for the further consideration of five shillings sterling to him in hand paid the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge He hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents Doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff confirm unto the said Gray Briggs his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or tracts parcel or parcels of land situate lying and being in Southampton County with have descended to the said Thomas from his father Thomas Gray decd. And also All those negro slaves which lately were in the possession of the said Thomas Gray decd and have also descended to him the said Thomas party to this deed as heir at law of the said Thomas his late father And also the reversion and reversions remainders and remainderments issues services of the said tract or tracts of land with the appurtenances and every part thereof

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
