To all People to whom these presents shall come Thomas Stephenson
 of the County of Southampton sendeth greeting knowye that I the said Thomas
 Stephenson for diverse good causes and valuable consideration me hereunto moving but
 more especially for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I
 have and beare unto my son Thomas Stephenson have given granted and confirmed
 and by these presents do give grant and confirm unto my said son Thom Stephenson
 a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton
 aforesaid and on the south side of Black water Beginning at a place in the
 meadow branch on the north side of Seacock swamp and thence up the said
 meadow to the house here chopt and from thence along a line of marked trees to
 a white oak and along a line of marked trees to a lightwood knot and so along a line
 of marked trees to a white oak a corner tree in William Boykins line thence
 along a line of marked trees to the first station including by estimation sixty five
 acres be the same more or less with all and singular the houses out houses
 buildings barns yards gardens orchards woods underwoods waters watercourses
 mines minerals and all and singular the profits commons privileges hereditaments and
 appurtenances whatsoever thunto belonging or in any manner of ways appertaining to
 have and to hold occupy possess and enjoy the before given and granted land and
 premises with their and every of their appurtenances unto him the said Tho. Stephenson
 him and assigns forever in full possession and estate of inheritance in fee simple
 and I the said Thomas Stephenson me my heirs and assigns forever all and singular
 the before given and granted land and premises with all and singular the appurtenances
 as aforesaid unto the said Thomas Stephenson his executors administrators and assigns
 against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever by these presents
