This Indenture made this fourteenth day of November in the year
 of our Lord Thousand seven hundred and sixty three Between Samuel Eley &
 Mary his wife of the parish of in the county of Granville in the
 province of North Carolina of the one part and Christopher Wade of the parish
 of Notaway in the county of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that
 the said Samuel Eley and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum
 of twelve pounds good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid the
 receipt whereof they doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully and entirely satisfied
 and paid have bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed by these presents
 with bargain sell alien enfeoff and forever confirmed unto the said Christopher Wade
 his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying on the east side of
 the Cypress Swamp in the county of Southampton and bounded as followeth
 Beginning at a black oak corner tree of Samuel Eley one of the parties herein
 named from thence upon a line of Thomas Sandfords to a gum standing in the
 Cypress Swamp from thence up the said swamp to a live oak a corner tree from
 thence along a line of marked trees to a pine sapling a corner tree & from thence
 straight line to the first station containing fifty acres more or less which
 said fifty acres of land more or less is part of a tract that Samuel Eley one of
 the parties herein named bought of Thomson Swann of the parish of Southham in
 the county of Cumberland in a deed bearing date the fifth day of November
 one thousand seven hundred and sixty two as in said deeds office will more
 fully appear To have and to hold the said land and premises together
 with all houses out houses gardens orchards woods underwoods mines minerals
 marshes and low grounds and every part & parcel thereof unto him the said
 Christopher Wade his heirs heirs and assigns forever and the said
 Samuel Eley and Mary his wife for themselves their heirs heirs and assigns
 shall and will warrant the said land and premises unto the said Christopher
 Wade his heirs heirs and assigns by force all manner of Persons laying any
 claim by from or under them the said Samuel Eley & Mary his wife in
 Witness whereof they hath hereunto set their hands & seals the day and
 date first above written
