At a Court held for the said County the 12 day of January 1764. The said Indenture and memorandum was further proved by the oath of John Britt a third witness thereto and ordered to be recorded

This Indenture made this tenth day of December in the third year of the reign of our sovereign lord George the third by the Grace of god of Great Britain, France and Ireland King defender of the Faith &c And in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty three between James Ridley of Southampton County of the one part & Beasant Dum of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Ridley for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said James Ridley do hereby acknowledge and himself sheweth to be fully satisfied contented and paid have granted bargain and sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff release and confirm unto the said Beasant Dum his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being on the south side of a branch called James branch in the aforesaid County of Southampton being apart of the land

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
