 execute or cause and procure to be made done & executed all such further & other Acts & Acts things & things
 devices and conveniences and assurances in the Law for the further or better conveying and Assuring the
 premises aforesaid unto the said Daniel Doyel his heirs and Assigns as by the said Daniel Doyel his
 heirs and Assigns or his or their council learned in the Law shall be reasonably directed or required, and
 also that he the said Thomas Benson the said Plantation tract or Parcel of Land and Premises with
 the appurtenances well Warrant & forever defend unto the said Daniel Doyel his heirs and Assigns
