To have and to hold all and singular the said Premises above mentioned and every part & Parcel thereof with their appurtenances unto the said Charles Briggs his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Charles Briggs his Heirs & Assigns forever and the said Elizabeth Briggs for herself her Heirs &c the above mentioned premises and every part thereof thereof against her and her heirs and against all & every other person or persons whatsoever to the said Charles Briggs his Heirs & Assigns forever shall & well warrant and forever defend by these presents in Writs Whereof the said Elizabeth Briggs hath hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the Day and year first above Written

This Indenture made this twelfth day of April in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and sixty four Between Joseph Bradshaw of the Parish of Notaway and County of Southampton of the one part and Daniel Fisher of the same parish and County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joseph Bradshaw for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen pounds to him in hand paid by the said Daniel Fisher at or before the executing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge Hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Daniel Fisher and to his heirs & assigns forever all that the said Joseph Bradshaw his Plantation tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the parish & County aforesaid containing two hundred and thirty acres to the same more or less being the Land the said Joseph Bradshaw purchased of Daniel Mackin and whereon he now lives bounded by the most known ancient & reputed bounds thereof and joining the lands of John Bennet and Robert Johnson John Bennet and William Jones and all houses outhouses fences orchards trees ways waters water courses profits commodities hereditaments & appurtenances to the said Tract or Parcel of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversion remainder & remainders rents & profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof and all the estate right title Interest property claim & Demand whatsoever of them the said Joseph Bradshaw of in or to the same or every part thereof to have & to hold the said plantation tract or parcel of Land premises with the appurtenances unto the the said
