money of Virginia to be paid on demand which payment well and truly to be made and
done bind myself my heirs Executors Assigns firmly by these presents sealed with
my seal and dated this 21st day of October 1763

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Francis Lowe and Eve
his wife their heirs Executors Assigns do and shall from time to time and at all times here
after well and truly observe perform fulfil and keep all and every the covenants grants articles
conditions and agreements which on their parts and behalfs are and ought to be observed
performed fulfilled & kept Particularly mentioned expressed and set down in one Indenture
of release bearing date the 21st day of October 1763 made or mentioned to be made
between the above bound Francis Lowe and Eve his wife of Northampton county in
North Carolina of the one part; & the above said Thomas Lankford of the Isles of Wight county
in Virginia of the other part: shall make such further or other conveyances and
assurances in the law for the better conveying and assuring the lands in the said Indenture
of release mentioned, from all incumbrances as by the said Thomas Lankford his heirs
and assigns or by his or their council learned in the law shall reasonably advise advise or
require all which if the above bound Francis Lowe & Eve his wife their heirs Executors Assigns
do faithfully perform without fraud or further delay then the obligation to be void and
of no effect otherwise to remain in full force virtue and power
