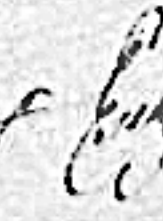

To all People to whom these presents shall come James Barden of the County of Southampton sendeth Greeting Know ye that I the said James Barden for divers good causes and valuable consideration me hereunto moving but more especially for and Inconsideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear unto my son Joseph Barden have given granted and confirmed and by these Presents do give grant and confirm unto my said son Joseph Barden a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and on the south side of Black Water beginning at a white oak on the South side of sea cock swamp a corner of the said Bayford line from Matthew's place thence by the said line 30 degrees East 200 pole to a white oak sapling 6 1/2 126 pole to a red oak by sea cock swamp side aforesaid then up the various courses of the run of the said swamp to the beginning containing by estimation of one hundred acres of land be the same more or less with all and singular the houses outhouses buildings Barns yards Gardens Orchards woods underwoods ways waters water courses mines minerals and all & singular the common profits privileges hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any manner of way appertaining to have hold occupy possess and enjoy the before given and grant land and premises with their and every of their appurtenances unto him the said Joseph Barden his Heirs & assigns for ever in pure possession and estate of Inheritance free simple, and I the said James Barden all and singular the before given and granted land and premises with all and singular the appurtenances as aforesaid unto the said Joseph Barden his Executors Administrators and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever by these presents defend In Witnes where I the said James Barden have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 11th day of April in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and sixty four
